Joe Roberts told the Board that his client did not want to disclose their identity and that because of this they would go through a trust. He stated that the trust would take possession of the contract and be involved with the contract. Mr. Roberts stated that he could not say much because he signed a nondisclosure agreement. Pat Gillespie stated that CCIDC is controlled by state law and it is her understanding that certain criteria are required, of the person moving into the park, by law. She stated that she would have to see the contract. Curtiss Schonenberg stated that they forwarded John Wagner a contract that the CCIDC had previously used with another real estate sale. Pat Gillespie stated that she will need to look at the contract. Mr. Roberts stated that he was not trying to be evasive, but that he could not change the agreement he made with his client. Pat stated that she would have to look at the contract to see if it met the criteria. Elizabeth Flint stated her understanding of the law and its purpose. Mr. Roberts stated that he could not give the Board any figures, with regards to infrasturcture and number of jobs created. Elizabeth Flint thanked John Wagner for bringing in Mr. Roberts. Curtiss Schonenberg told Mr. Roberts to submit the contract he had to the City Attorney, and if there are any concerns the Board would get back with him. Pat stated that she would review the contract and get back with Mr. Roberts as quickly as possible. Elizabeth Flint asked how much land they are interested in and she was told tracts D-1 and E. Mr. Roberts stated that he would like blueprints and other information to bring to his client and Elizabeth Flint told Mr. Roberts that Donald would have that information.
