1. **Call to Order.**

Mayor Dungen called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

2. **Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation.**

Mayor Dungen led the Pledge of Allegiance and Invocation.

Mayor Dungen then moved to Agenda Item #5.

5. **Executive Session: In Accordance with Texas Government Code, Subchapter D, Section 551.074, Personnel Matters regarding Hiring a City Manager.**

Mayor Dungen closed the regular session and entered into executive Session at 6:34 pm. The Executive Session Closed at 6:40 pm.
