BULK GARBAGE COLLECTION GUIDELINES CITY OF COLUMBUS, TEXAS

Bulk Garbage Pickup is provided by the City's Contractor, Texas Disposal Systems (TDS), as a part of residential monthly garbage service.

1. One monthly curbside Bulk Garbage collection per month will be provided for residential customers on a call-in basis. There is a restriction of three cubic yards per collection. All Bulk Garbage will be collected at the curbside and must be ready for pick up by 7:00 a.m. on the day of collection.

- 2. All brush and tree trimmings should be less than 4 feet in length and not more than 3 inches in diameter. They should be bundled and stacked at the curb. TDS will **not** pick up trimmings and brush from commercial tree service companies.
- 3. Any item containing a refrigerant/Freon must be tagged by a certified refrigeration technician, stating that the Freon has been removed.
- 4. Collection **excludes** construction material, tires, paint, motor oil, tree trunks, cement, solvents, or any hazardous waste.
- 5. The City of Columbus also operates a Recycling Center located at 1427 Montezuma St. which is open on Tuesday 8 a.m.-12 p.m., Friday 8 a.m.-12 p.m. and 1 p.m.-5 p.m., and Saturday 8 a.m.-12 p.m. The Recycling Center accepts #1 and #2 plastics, newspaper, cardboard, junk mail/magazines, used motor oil, and metal.
